With reference to the published race distances for Class G competitors, and discussions with the SA Rally-Raid CEO, Technical delegate and SxS representative:

To recap the published information:

Super Events

Qualifying race and loop 1 on Friday and loop one Saturday

Standard Event

Qualifying race on Friday and loop one on Saturday

One Day Events

Qualifying race and loop one

Marathon Events

Qualifying race on Friday, loop one on Saturday and loop three on Sunday.

SA Rally-Raid will on individual requests, grant competitors dispensation to complete the full race distance of the Mpumalanga 400, but Championship points will only be scored at end of loop 1 on Saturday.

This dispensation could also be granted for future events, pending the performance based on reliability of the field at the Mpumalanga event as previously published in the attached document.

- All competitors must report to Race HQ to confirm that permission to complete loop 3 of the event has been granted.
- Competitors will strictly compete under the SR's in loop 3. **No exception.**
- RallySafe must remain operational up to the final control.
- DSP time bar per event will be enforced. **No exception.**
- Event time bars will not be extended **under any circumstances.**

Until such time that there are bona-fide FIA T3 and T4 entries, all current vehicles will compete in Class G. Only these vehicles will be classified in the overall Special Vehicle Championship.

We look forward to our co-operation and maintaining the Championship status of the category.
